## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

For the week of April 5, 2020

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- Josh talked about two extremes of people: those that are kind and compassionate and those that are rude and blunt. Who is it that comes to mind when you think of kind/compassionate? Tell us about them.
- Tell us about a time that a "blunt" person told you a truth that ended up being helpful to you...although you may not have liked it at the time.
- Which do you tend to lean towards being? Kind/loving or blunt/rude?
- Read I Peter 2:1-2. How does vs. 1 influence v. 2 and vice versa?
- I Peter 2:11 calls the things in v. 1 "fleshly lusts." Which of the five things listed in v. 1 is most tempting for you?
- Read I Peter 2:12, 15. Can you think of a time where you saw these things happen?
- Read I Peter 2:16. What would it look like for a person to use their "liberty for a cloak of maliciousness?"
- Read I Peter 2:19-21 & talk about some examples of what this looks like
- Take some time to pray together.

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
