For the week of May 31, 2020

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to “break the ice” and get people talking)

- It’s been 12 weeks since we started “social distancing.” What are two things about this time that you will talk about 10 years from now?
- What is one thing that you know now that you wish you would have known 10 to 20 years ago?
- What comes to mind when you think of “worship?”
- How would you define “ignorant?” What are some potential characteristics of someone that worships “ignorantly?” (Acts 17:22-23)
- Read II Corinthians 1:18-20. What is one promise that you have seen God fulfill in your life?
- “It’s not a matter of understanding. It is a matter of trusting.” What does this statement mean to you?
- Read James 1:17. Can you think of a time that God provided for you and it led you to worship?
- “Worship is not something we do out of obedience, it is something we do out of understanding.” How did we see this truth in Abraham’s life? How have you seen this truth in your life?
- Take some time to pray together.
