One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- What are the most controversial <u>non-Biblical</u> topics among your peers?
- Read Philippians 2:3-4. What person (other than Jesus) comes to mind when you read these verses? Why?
- Compare Philippians 2:3-4 to Ephesians 4:31-32. How are these verses similar? How are they different?
- What are some practical ways that we can live out Philippians 2:3?
 - What about Philippians 2:4?
 - What about Philippians 2:7-8?
- Can you think of a time that someone was kind, considerate, and humble with you in a potentially divisive conversation? How did it help?
- Is there someone that you've been experiencing "division" with? What truths can you apply from this passage to help in that relationship?
