For the week of September 27, 2020

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- What trophy are you most proud of, ashamed of, or has a cool/funny story behind it?
- If you could be #1 at anything in the world, what would you want it to be?
- Read Colossians 2:13-18. There were men that were judging them because they didn't agree about 'traditional' things like meat, drink, holy days, etc. What are some ways this happens today? What is the significance of the word "therefore" in v. 16? (Hint: Jesus did something in vs. 13-15 and it relates to vs. 16-18)
- Where, other than Jesus, are you most tempted to seek your identity/worth?
- When praying for other believers, what are the top requests you make? Are they similar to Colossians 1:9?
- Colossians 1:10-11 contain evidences that Jesus is #1 in our lives. Colossians 1:9 tells us how to make Jesus #1. Why is it so tempting to focus on vs. 10-11 rather than v. 9?
- Do you see any of these evidences (vs. 10-11) that God is #1 in the lives of anyone in the room with you right now? Please share.
- What are some practical ways that you can seek "the knowledge of his will" (v. 9) on a daily basis?
