

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

For the week of October 4, 2020

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to “break the ice” and get people talking)

- What’s the thing that you most often day dream about? What do you think about more than anything else?
- Col. 2:15 (“He made a show of them openly.”) Have you ever made a show of someone openly? Has it ever happened to you?
- Gal. 4:3-7 / Col. 1:15-19. What are some of the parallel themes in these passages?
- Col. 2:6-9. What are some of the things that we can allow ourselves to be “enslaved in.”
- Who, or what else, do we make the main character in our faith journey? “You are not the main character in the redemption story. Jesus is.”
- Col. 1:15 / 1:19. “Study the life of Christ, and you will know the heart of God.” What are some things Jesus did to prove His preeminence?
- What would we change if we began to live like Jesus?
“Part of making Jesus #1 is when we stop theorizing about what He does and doesn’t approve of, and we start doing the things that He did.”
- What area of your life do you need to give Jesus preeminence in?
- Take some time to pray together.
