For the week of November 1, 2020

- Read I Cor. 4:8-11. According to v. 11, why does God allow us to be "troubled, perplexed, etc.?"
- What does it look like to have "the life of Jesus manifest in our lives?"
- How does this direct our thoughts toward personal and world evangelism?
- What can you do to share this "treasure" in your "earthen vessel" this week?
- What can you do to encourage a missionary this week?
