For the week of November 29, 2020

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- If you had to pick a meat other than turkey for Thanksgiving, what would you choose?
- What is one thing that you are good at growing...or wish you were good at growing?
- Read John 1:14. John and others got to actually 'see' Jesus. In what ways do we 'have it better' than they did?
- Read Luke 8:4-8. What are the four types of 'soil?'

Take some time to pray together

- Read Luke 8:11-15. Describe what each of these 'soils' would look like as a person today.
- Josh talked about the how they farmed differently than we do now. He said, "Any delay in plowing led to the results seen in these verses." In what ways can we 'cultivate' the soil by the "way side?" (vs. 5, 12)
- Did you struggle with doubting God prior to being saved? If so, what are some things that helped you come to faith? How did someone "cultivate" the soil in your life?
- Is there someone that you know that is doubting? What are some ways that you can 'sow and cultivate' the seed?
