For the week of December 20, 2020

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- Would you rather have Frosty or Rudolph as your friend?
- "Must be nice" is a phrase we hear often. What is something that you have seen that led you to saying this phrase?
- Read Matthew 13:17, then II Corinthians 3:4-8. Talk about the ways that we "have it better" living in grace than they did living under law.
- Read Matthew 13:15 and talk about how "their response determined their experience."
- Read Matthew 13:16-17 and talk about how "their response determined their experience."
- What are some ways that our "hearts wax gross," we close our ears, or not see with our eyes?
- Read Matthew 13:11-12. How have you seen God "give" to "abundance" to those that are seeking truth. (NOT referring to material goods, but truth)
- How have you seen God "take away" from those that are not seeking truth? (NOT referring to material goods, but truth)
- We've spent four weeks talking about how "The Word was Made Flesh" and how "Jesus changes everything." What is your big "takeaway" from this parable?
