For the week of December 6, 2020

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- Would you rather spend Christmas with your group of friends or have them each be replaced by their favorite celebrity?
- ⁻ What has been the most awkward part of life during the Covid crisis?
- Read Mk. 4:16-17, Lk. 8:13, and Mt. 13:20-21. What do these verses say about the person characterized as stony ground?
- What do those verses say about the type of circumstances that the stony ground is facing?
- Why is it so tempting to "fall away" during difficult times in life?
- Josh said, "Deliverance requires faith in the Word." Can you think of anyone you've seen walk through a hard time as a result of trusting Jesus?
- Read I Peter 1:6-9. Trials don't change truth, they just cloud it. What are some truths in this passage that can help during times of tribulation?
- Do you have a "go-to" verse that has helped through storms in your life?
- Read II Corinthians 1:3-4. As a "sower," what does it look like when we live out these verses?
- Share a time that someone lived out these verses with you.
- Take some time to pray together.

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
