For the week of January 24, 2021

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- Would you rather be able to control animals (but not humans) with your mind or control electronics with your mind?
- Josh talked about people's "last words." What are some words that someone you've known has shared that have always stuck with you?
- Read Jesus' "new commandment" in John 13:34-35 and His prayer in John 17:20-21. Why were these things so important?
- What are some things that you have seen that hinder love and unity among believers? Do you personally struggle with any of these?
- Read Romans 12:9. Would you agree that "evil" leads to "dissimulation?" (wearing a mask) How so? Can you give an example?
- Read Romans 12:10. How have you seen others do this? What are some ways that we can do a better job of this?
- According to Romans 12:11, what should be our motivation for having the right relationship with other believers? What difference does this make?
- "Anything you do in life can be done as an act of worship." Discuss this thought and how it challenges you.
- Out of all the things listed in Romans 12:9-13, which one stands out as most important for you at this time in your life?
