DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

For the week of March 28, 2021

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- Would you rather live in a house on the beach or in the mountains?
- What was the first bill and/or accomplishment that you were excited that it was "paid in full" or "completed?"
- After hearing the sermon, how would you explain to someone what the word "tetelestai" means?
- Read Hebrews 10:11-12. Compare and contrast the priests and their work in verse 11 to Jesus and His work in verse 12.
- Read Hebrews 10:1-10. Talk about what these verses mean as a group.
- If a person can "lose their salvation," then is that salvation based on grace or works? See Romans 11:6 and discuss as a group.
- Read Romans 6:8-12 and talk about ways that we "let" sin "reign" in our lives and what it looks like to "reckon yourself dead unto sin."
- After salvation, should we seek to keep the law or walk in the Spirit? See these passages for help: Romans 8:1-4 and Galatians 3:1-3, 21-25
- Jesus said, "It is finished." How has this impacted your life?
- Take some time to pray together.
