For the week of April 4, 2021

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to “break the ice” and get people talking)

- Would you rather be fluent in all languages or be a master of every musical instrument?
- What are your favorite movie lines to quote? Which ones annoy you the most when someone else quotes them?
- Jesus was prepared for death in Luke 23:46. If you're comfortable with it, please share your salvation testimony.
- Read Mark 8:6. “Set before” is the same word as “commend” in Luke 23:46. What can we learn from this comparison?
- “A life that is committed to Jesus seeks to know and be guided by the Scriptures.” Read Psalm 119:104-105 and talk about what it looks like to be guided by the Word (and vice versa).
- “A life that is committed to Jesus seeks to be about the Father's business.” Read II Timothy 1:9-12 and talk about what it looks like to be about the Father's business (and vice versa).
- What hinders us from being guided by the Word and being about the Father's business?
- What steps do you need to take to be committed to God's Word and His business?
- Take some time to pray together.
