DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

For the week of May 30, 2021

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- Memorial Day is the unofficial kickoff to summer. What were your favorite things about summer while growing up? How about now?
- The sermon was about a "memorial." What is one of the best (or most moving) memorials you have ever visited?
- Read Joshua 4:6-7. If you were a parent during that time, what details would you include in your answer to that question?
- Can you think of something in your life that your children (or friends) have asked you about that allowed you to brag on something God did?
- Read Psalm 78:4-8. According to these verses, why was it so important for them to tell their kids about the things that the Lord had done?
- What is something that God has done, or is doing, in your life?
- What are some ways that we can intentionally remember these things? (After all, the stones were put up to help them intentionally remember)
- "God's blessings are meant to be enjoyed and shared." Can you think of a time that someone shared a blessing...and it blessed you?
- What can we do to be more intentional about telling others about the way(s) that God has/is blessing us? How might this habit help others...or even us?
