DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

For the week of July 18, 2021

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- If you could only listen to music from one decade...which decade would you choose?
- If you were taking someone through your hometown, what's a place/story that you would share with them?
- The theme of Colossians 2 (and the last three weeks) has been "Jesus is enough." What has been your 'takeaway?'
- Read through Colossians 2:16-23 and point out some of the characteristics/actions of someone that is not focusing on Christ.
- Do you find it tempting to focus on things 'to do,' rather than on Jesus? Why do you think this happens?
- Read Galatians 3:1-3 and discuss.
- Colossians 2:18 talks about men "beguiling" us. This means that they "declare us unworthy." Are there things that others say/do in an attempt to make us feel unworthy?
- What does it look like for someone to focus on Colossians 3:1-4 versus someone focusing on Colossians 3:5-10? How can these two things coexist?
- Take some time to pray together.
