For the week of September 26, 2021

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- Read II Corinthians 12:9 and summarize it in your own words.
- Read Titus 2:11-12. It says that grace teaches us to "deny ungodliness and worldly lusts." What are some of the worldly lusts/ungodliness that Christians that today?
- <sup>-</sup> Why did Paul pray I Thessalonians 5:28 for the church at Thessalonica?
- What is the difference between a Christian who is motivated by grace and someone who does good works to gain a right standing with God?
