For the week of October 10, 2021

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to “break the ice” and get people talking)

- What celebrity do most people say you look like?
- Most celebrities have a “charity of choice.” If you had to choose one charity to support (that’s not church-related), which one would it be?
- Who is the most giving/generous person that you have known? Tell us about them.
- “Most people WANT to be generous.” Do you agree with this statement? Why or why not? What keeps most people from being generous?
- Read 1 Timothy 6:6-19 aloud together. Which part is most convicting to you personally? Share why it sticks out to you.
- Give. Save. Spend. Which is hardest for you? Which is easiest? Which is done in the most Biblically responsible way?
- One of the ways to manage money responsibly is to follow a budget. Is keeping a budget easy or difficult for you? What advantages have you experienced while living on a budget?
- Debt is not forbidden, but it can be dangerous. If you’re living with debt, what’s one change you could make to pay off your debt sooner?
- Do you have any ideas or tips that have made saving more doable for you?
- What’s one change you need to make in your life in order to be a better manager of your finances?
- Take some time to pray together.
