DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

For the week of October 17, 2021

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- Micah talked about different styles of music. What is your preferred music style? Has it always been this way? Bonus: What was your first concert?
- "Grace is undeserved kindness." What was one of the most gracious things anyone has ever done for you?
- What are we commanded to do in I Timothy 2:1? Give examples of each.
 - "Supplications" Humble request on my behalf
 - "Prayers" Worship and trust in Almighty God
 - "Intercessions" The verbal form means "to fall in with a person, to draw near so as to converse familiarly"
- Micah said, "Even the good we do tends to have selfish motives." Can we obey I Timothy 2:1 w/ selfish motivations? How so?
- Paul used "therefore" in I Timothy 2:1. What was he referring to? When we understand this...what difference does it make on our understanding of I Timothy 2:1? How does this eliminate selfish motivations?
- Paul told Timothy to give grace (by following 2:1) to three groups of people. Who were these people?
 - 1:18-2:1?
 - 2.2-32
 - 2:4-6?
- Look back at the definitions in the third question. Give examples of how to pray these three things for each of the three groups.
- Is it more difficult for you to give grace to one of these groups more than the others?
- Micah asked, "Are we living for our comfort or God's glory?" Talk about ways that we can do either of these?
- Take some time to pray together.
