DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

For the week of October 24, 2021

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- What was your favorite subject in school? Did you have a favorite teacher?
- "There are things you just have to know in order to succeed." What is one of your favorite pieces of advice to share with others.
- Can you give an example of what it looks like to "mortify" one of the things found in Colossians 3:5-9?
- What are the two commands found in Colossians 3:1-2? Give some examples of what it looks like to follow these commands.
- Which is easier for you...following vs. 1-2 or vs. 5-9? Why?
- What significance does Colossians 2:4 have in this context?
- There are two truths in Colossians 3:1-3 that empower us to win the battles of the will and mind:
 - 1. We are dead with Christ (3:3, 2:20)
 - 2. We are risen with Christ (3:1)
 - These things happen at salvation. Would anyone like to share their salvation story?
- Romans 6:11-13 give us insight into what it looks like to be dead with Christ and risen with Christ. According to these verses, what difference can/should these truths make?
- How do you consider yourself dead to sin and alive to God?
- Is there a sin that tempts you to believe that you are still "alive" unto it? What advice does Romans 6:16-18 give in these cases?
