DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

For the week of November 7, 2021

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- What is the most memorable game that you've ever attended?
- It may not have been a "streaker," but what is the funniest/weirdest thing that you've ever seen at a public event?
- Read Colossians 3:12-14. Which of these is the easiest for you to "put on?" Which is the most difficult?
- In your opinion, is it easier to "put on" the things in vs. 12-14 or to "put off/mortify" the things in vs. 5-9?
- How does "knowing WHO we are and WHOSE we are" make a difference in the life of a believer? (Colossians 3:12a)
- Of the three things listed in Colossians 3:12a about the identity of the believer, which is the most meaningful to you? Why?
- Read Colossians 3:16. Talk about a time that someone "taught" or "admonished" you spiritually.
- How did you react to this? What difference did it make?
- Which of the three things that we need to remember (identity-v. 12a, authority-v. 15, community-v. 16) has been the most helpful to you in regards to "putting on" the things in vs. 12-14?
- What is your "takeaway" from these verses? Is there something you need to "put on?" Is there something that you need to remember?
- Take some time to pray together.
