## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

For the week of March 27, 2022

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- What is the biggest fish you have ever caught?
- Describe a time when you had a near death experience and the thoughts that went through your mind.
- How would you summarize the story of Jonah?
- Has there been a time in your life that you knew God was calling you to do something and you really did not want to do it?
- Jonah did not like the people of Nineveh. What groups of people are Christians tempted to see as "less than" in our day?
- Read Jonah 1:3. What are some ways that we do what Jonah did in this verse?
- What has God used in your past (or present) to get your attention?
- Read Hebrews 12:5-6. Discuss these verses along with the quote, "Every act of disobedience has a storm attached to it."
- How do things change when we begin to 'experience grace' in the midst of our storms and/or chastening? See Titus 2:11-13.
- What has God asked you to do that you haven't done? Is there any area of disobedience in your life?
- Take some time to pray together.

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
