DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

For the week of March 13, 2022

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- On Sunday, Josh talked about "Wordle." What is your 'guilty pleasure' game of choice?
- What is something in your house that is "sanctified?" Something that is "set apart." (people aren't allowed to use/touch, except for its intended use)
- Read I Corinthians 6:11. Those that have believed the Gospel are "sanctified" (set apart). God no longer lives in "temples made with hands." He lives in us. What implications does this truth have?
- Read I Thessalonians 5:23. Talk about the differences between body, soul, and spirit.
- On Sunday, we talked about being "justified, glorified, and sanctified" at salvation. Talk about how each of these apply to our body, soul, and spirit.
- Our soul is made up of our mind, emotions, and will. How does the enemy attack these areas?
- Read Ephesians 6:17. How does understanding the truths above, and "taking the helmet of salvation," give us safety from these attacks?
- "What consumes our minds controls our lives." How have you seen this true in your life or in others'?
- What are some practical ways to be vigilant and give proactive attention to walking in Spirit (taking up helmet of salvation)?
