## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

For the week of April 10, 2022

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- If you had \$5K to make a home improvement, what would you do?
- Time for a humble brag...what is one of the kindest things that you have done for someone (that didn't necessarily 'deserve' it)?
- Read Jonah 3:1-2. Does the fact that God came unto Jonah a second time have any significance to you?
- Jonah's proclamation of God's message was 'half-hearted' to say the least (see Jonah 3:4 - only 8 words - - see Jonah 4:1 - he was upset that they repented). What do we learn about God through this?
- Read Romans 10:13-14 and Jonah 2:9. These two verses show us that evangelism requires an understanding of two things: 1. They have to HEAR truth - 2. Only God can do it. Talk about the problems that we tend to have with these simple thoughts.
- Read Jonah 4:1-3. Jonah hated the Ninevites so much that he did not want them to "experience grace." Josh talked about a few groups of people that Christians tend to treat in a similar fashion. Is there a group of people that you are tempted to view in this way? Why is it so easy to forget that these people need Jesus?
- Read I Corinthians 6:9-11. How do these verses recalibrate our thoughts toward people that are 'different' than us?
- The message of Jonah 3-4 is, "Stop yelling and start telling." Talk about practical ways that you can start doing this.
- Take some time to pray together.
