## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

For the week of May 15, 2022

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- On Sunday we talked about music genres. What is your guilty pleasure music? (When you work out, when you're doing chores, when you're alone)
- "Worshiper is not a volunteer position. It is a reason for existence."
  - How does this idea change the way that we live our day-to-day lives?
  - How does it change the way we enter into corporate worship on Sundays?
- "The Sunday song service is a platform and a launchpad...."
  - How can (or how has) God used the Sunday song service as a launch pad for you in your life?
- Look at Ephesians 3. List some things Paul says we were "made for."
  - How does this change the way that we worship?
- "Being Spirit-filled means you have ongoing fellowship with God."
  - How often do you take advantage of this relationship?
- "Until worship is about spirit and truth, it will continue to be about location, tradition, and personal preference."
  - How have you seen this happen (not just in music) in your life?
- "The Word of God doesn't merely stir affections but it informs our minds." Name a time when singing songs that are true has strengthened your faith.
- Would you say that you err more on the side of "heart" or "head" when it comes to music?
- Look at Colossians 3:17, 3:23, and Eph. 3:20-21. How do these fit the idea: "You were made to worship in spirit and truth"?
