DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

For the week of May 29, 2022

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started.

- On Sunday, Andrew started out by talking about some wild and crazy things he'd done. What are some of the most wild or crazy things you've ever done that left you saying, "What in the world was I thinking?"
- What is a way that you have served or volunteered in any capacity that brought you great joy and fulfillment?
- There are three callings that God places upon the life of every believer (a calling to salvation... sanctification... service) Of the last two, which one do you find to be more of an ongoing struggle for you?
- Read I Corinthians 12:12-20, and discuss answers to this question, Why is every member of the body and its unique contribution important?
- Read I Corinthians 22-27. What are some practical ways these verses can be or are being lived out specifically in your LifeGroup?
- Read I Corinthians 12:28-31. Pauls says that all different spiritual gifts are important. But what does he go on to say in the next chapter is most important irregardless of our gifts? Why does this matter?
- In the Christian life, God's command to serve by "Loving God. Loving Others" is not optional. So why do you think so many Christians make it optional, both inside and outside of the church?
- According to Ephesians 2:10, we are not saved <u>by</u> good works, but we were created <u>as</u> God's handiwork, created <u>for</u> good works. Discuss this thought and what the end of verse 10 means.
- Take a moment to share ways that God has gifted you (or identify a gift you see in someone else in the group) and some ways that you are using that gift or could use it?
- Take some time to pray together.
