## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

For the week of June 12, 2022

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- What is the wildest thing that you have seen from someone that was panhandling or asking the public for food?
- We finished the series "Made for This" on Sunday. What were the three things that we were "made for" and how would you explain each of them in your own words?
- Is it a fair to compare a panhandler that uses donations to buy alcohol to a Christian that uses their life for something other than God's intended purpose? Why or why not?
- Ephesians 5 addresses wives, husbands, children, and fathers. Why is it so important to "worship, connect, and serve" in each of these relationships?
- Read each of these passages and identify: who is being addressed, how they are to "made to" serve, and how they are "made to" worship:
  - Ephesians 5:22-24
  - Ephesians 5:25-33
  - Ephesians 6:1-3
  - Ephesians 6:4
- Talk about why you do (or do not) agree with this statement: "The home is the primary place that we grow in our faith." (or vice versa)
- "We CONNECT as families by SERVING one another as an act of WORSHIP." How does this truth help you? Talk about one way that you can/should start living this out at home.
- Take some time to pray together as a group.
