## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

For the week of July 31, 2022

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started.

- Andrew started Sunday's message talking about coffee. What is the perfect cup of coffee? Weak, medium, dark, decaf, creamer or no?
  Defend your position.
- In the movie Elf, he finds a coffee shop that sells "the world's <u>best</u> cup of coffee". Are you someone who could watch Elf all year round, only during Christmas time, or preferably never again?
- The story in John 2 sets many precedents for **who** Jesus was and **why** Jesus came. In your own words, describe the answer to those two things.
- In this story, Jesus put his blessing and approval upon marriage. How is marriage under attack in our culture, and how can we both biblically and practically stand for God's view of marriage?
- We learned that "All of Life is Worship", meaning Jesus should be invited into every area of our lives. It's easy to invite Jesus into certain areas of our lives (Sundays, LifeGroup, etc.) What is one area that you sometimes struggle to invite Jesus into?
- Jesus came to accomplish God's plan to make all things new, both now and forever. What is one way God is trying to make you new right now?
- Read John 17:1-5. In Jesus' prayer to the Father, it was clear that his purpose was to bring God what? Read Revelation 4:11. How can our lives accomplish this same purpose?
- What are some practical ways that we can make our lives about his glory and not our own? What do you anticipate most about Jesus making ALL things new? Take time to pray together.
