For the week of July 24, 2022

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- Josh talked about some cool things that he has experienced first hand. What are two things that are at the top of your list?
- What is it about personally experiencing something that makes it so much better than just hearing about it?
- Of all the things that you have seen or experienced about God, what are two things that are at the top of your list that you want others to experience first hand?
- Read John 1:39, 46. "Following Jesus can be described in three words, 'Come and See." Do you agree with this statement? Why?
- Read John 1:38. Jesus' question was "What seek ye?" He knew the answer to this question, but he wanted to hear them articulate it. What significance does this truth have to you?
- They spent time with Jesus in the place where he dwelt in John 1:39.
 They were able to communicate with and learn directly from Jesus. Talk about ways that you are currently doing these two things.
- What men in John 1:35-37 sought out others to spend time with them with Jesus? Josh said, "Disciples are not content to walk with God alone." What are some practical ways to do this?
- Do you tend to have more trouble spending time with Jesus or spending time with Jesus with others? How can we help you with this?
