DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

For the week of November 6, 2022

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- What is a place that people love to eat that you can't stand?
- Would you describe yourself as more of a thinker or a feeler? Do you tend to 'over-think' situations or more 'go with the flow'?
- Read Proverbs 3:5-6. What does it mean to trust the Lord with all of your heart?
- In what ways did the people in John 7:1-13 trust God...or not trust God?
- What areas of life are easy for you to trust God? Are there any areas that are more difficult?
- What does it really mean to "not lean on your own understanding?"
- In what ways did the people in John 7:1-13 lean on their own understanding...or not do this?
- What areas of your life is it tempting to lean on our own understanding?
- What does it mean to "acknowledge God in all your ways?"
- In what ways did the people in John 7:1-13 acknowledge God?
- What areas of your life do you tend to acknowledge God most in?
- The promise attached to this command is that God will "direct your path?" What does this mean?
