One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- What was your favorite food that you had over Thanksqiving?

- Read John 7:15-16. How would you summarize what the Jews said and how Jesus responded?
- Josh talked about the need to "speak God's Word." The tendency we have is to speak our <u>own</u> word or the words <u>someone else</u>. Which of these is the biggest temptation for you?
- What are some practical ways that you can start speaking <u>God's</u> Word?
- Read John 7:17. Has there been a time that God confirmed the validity of His Word to you as you chose to follow Him in it?
- There is power in your testimony if it points others to the Word." What is a story that you like to share that has a truth from Scripture attached to it?
- Read John 7:18. In what ways are you tempted to seek your own glory, rather than God's?
- What are some practical ways to "seek God's glory?"
