

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

For the week of November 13, 2022

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to “break the ice” and get people talking)

- Would you rather have turkey or ham for Thanksgiving?
- Who has had the greatest spiritual influence on your life? What kinds of things did they do that made a spiritual impact?
- Read through Acts 7:51-60 and talk about the things that Stephen said, or did, that showed his love and care for others.
- Why do we find it so difficult to show this same kind of love and care for others...specifically for “difficult” people?
- What would make it possible for you to be calm and sure in the middle of extreme danger?
- Stephen was called to “serve tables” in Acts 6:2-5. At the same time, he fulfilled his other responsibility to be a faithful witness to the lost in Acts 7. Which is easier for you...serving tables or witnessing?
- How has God called you to “serve tables?”
- Who has God called you to “witness” to?
- In Acts 7:51, they “resisted” God. Are there any areas in which you are “resisting” the Lord? Is there something you need to surrender to Him?
- Take some time to pray together.
