- Tamar's actions seemed to have an impact on the lives of David and Judah. How does the fact that people are watching you in your brokenness help you?
- Tamar's gentle approach with Judah seems to indicate that there was a spirit of forgiveness. Talk about the role of forgiveness in brokenness.
