DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

For the week of June 18, 2023

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- What is one of the funniest, or coolest, gifts that you have either given, or been given, for a holiday like Father's Day?
- How well do you know the people in this room? What is something positive that you know about another person in the room that others might not know?
- We "know" a lot of people, but we don't "know" a lot of people. Other than family members, who are the 1-2 people that you "know" best?
- Talk about how you grew to know these people so well. What difference has "knowing" them so well made in your life, or in theirs?
- Il Peter 1:5 tells us to "add knowledge" about Jesus. Talk about why this is so important and the difference it can make as we do it.
- Josh gave some practical ways to "add knowledge." They were to read about Jesus, think about Jesus, and discuss Jesus. Talk about what each of these look like in our lives on a daily basis.
- Can you think of any other practical ways to "add knowledge" of Jesus in our lives? What are some things that have helped you to do this?
- Why do we find it so easy to seek to add knowledge in so many areas of our lives, but find it so difficult to consistently seek to grow in our knowledge of Jesus?
- How can we help each other to do this?
