DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

For the week of July 9, 2023

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- What is an odd word and/or phrase that you, or someone in your family, uses that others might not understand?
- Word association...What is the first thing that comes to mind when you hear these words...Manly? Lovely? Smelly?
- Before listening to Sunday's sermon, how would you have defined the term "godliness?"
- Josh defined "godliness" as "worshipping well" by putting the two Greek words together - "Eu" (acting well) and "Sebo" (devoted, worship). How does this definition differ from the typical English definition of "possessing God like qualities?"
- Read Titus 2:11-14. What do these verses show as being the source of strength for being able to "deny ungodliness?"
- Read I Timothy 3:16. Talk about how Jesus is the perfect example of godliness. Talk about what He did in each of the following verses that showed that He "worshipped well:" Luke 2:49, John 8:49, Luke 22:42
- How does I Corinthians 10:31 help us to remember that "all of life is worship?"
- What would it look like for us to "add godliness" by "worshipping well?"
- Take some time to pray together.
