For the week of December 18, 2022

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- What's the most embarrassing, or funny, thing that you've seen at a wedding, funeral, or public event?
- When you think of funny, or unpredictable, people in your family, who comes to mind?
- So far, we've seen the broken stories of Tamar and Rahab in the genealogy of Jesus. If you had to explain why their names (and thereby, their stories) were included in the family tree, what would you say?
- Read John 5:17. How does the truth that God is always at work impact our lives? How does it change our outlook in times of brokenness?
- Rahab faced a moment of decision when she had to tell where the spies had gone. Talk about how this was a step of faith.
- Share a time that you were in a moment of decision and took a step of faith, or share a time that God prompted you to take an action by faith.
- Although Rahab is still known as "the harlot," she did not let her past to determine her destiny. How are we tempted to allow this to happen in our lives?
