 How do we balance hating our sin with not allowing guilt and shame to rule and reign in our hearts?
- What are some ways that we use the, "It's just a little poison" excuse in our lives?
- Christ isn't all if we lack unity.
 Why is unity and community so important in our battle against the flesh?
- Read Col. 3:12-14 and Gal. 5:22-23.
 What does it look like practically to "put these things on"?
- Share about a time when God used unity and community to help you through a battle (with either sin or circumstances.)
- Read Col. 3:17 and Rom. 6:22.
 What kind of perspective do we typically have when living for ourselves?
 How does our perspective change when we are living for God?
- Read Col. 3:15-17. What are some practical steps given here to help us?
