## **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

For the week of January 15, 2023

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- Tell us about a time that you won a contest/drawing.
- What is one of the best/worst experiences that you've had at an establishment? How has it formed your view of that business?
- Is it fair that an employee's actions/words determine the worth of the business they represent?
- Read Colossians 4:2-5. Who is the primary concern in these verses? Who are these people in <u>your</u> life at this moment?
- Why is it so easy to forget (or be unconcerned) about the spiritual condition of those around us?
- Colossians 4:2 tells us to "walk in wisdom." What does it mean to "walk in wisdom?" What are some examples of how to do this, and how not to do this?
- Read and talk about I Thessalonians 4:11-12 and I Peter 2:11-12.
- Read Colossians 4:6. What does it mean to "speak with grace?" What are some examples of how to do this, and how not to do this?
- When speaking to "them that are without," are there certain topics that are wise to avoid?
- Colossians 4:5 says to "redeem the time." This literally means to "make the most" of the opportunities we have with unbelievers. What are some examples of how to do this, and how not to do this?
- Take some time to pray together.
