For the week of February 19, 2023

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- If you were given \$10K to spend on someone other than yourself, how would you spend it?
- Who is the most giving/generous person that you have known? Tell us about them.
- Josh said that, as Americans, we are "rich." What are the things that you "enjoy" (I Timothy 6:17) that make you 'feel' rich?
- What are the temptations that rich people face according to the following verses? What preventative measures do these verses tell us to take that will help us against these temptations?
 - I Timothy 6:17
 - I Timothy 6:6-11
- What are 'rich' people commanded to do in I Timothy 6:18-19? What does this look like in everyday life?
- Read Acts 20:35. Share a time that you experienced this for yourself.
- "Most people WANT to be generous." Do you agree with this statement? Why or why not? What keeps most people from being generous?
- One of the ways to manage money responsibly is to follow a budget. Is keeping a budget easy or difficult for you? What advantages have you experienced while living on a budget?
- I Timothy 6:17-19 talks about "enjoying" and "investing" "riches." Talk about what it looks like to live with these two in balance.
