DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

For the week of March 12, 2023

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- What is one of the funniest memories you have from a family gettogether?
- What is the most loving relationship you've ever seen?
- Ephesians 5 talks about the responsibility of husbands to love. When this happens, it starts an "energizing cycle." When it doesn't happen, it starts a "crazy cycle." Talk about how you have seen these cycles take place.
- Earlier we talked about the most loving relationship you've ever seen? Read Eph. 5:25. Does this verse show an example of a loving relationship? Talk about how a husband's love for his wife can look like Jesus' love for the church.
- Why would God need to command husbands to love their wives?
- Read I Peter 3:7. What does this kind of love look like in a marriage?
- Josh said that when a wife is criticizing, complaining, or nagging, there is often an underlying desire and that is a need for love. Talk about how you have seen this.
- Read Eph. 5:28-29. When we recognize a problem in the body, we take care of it. In other words, love is shown when problems arise. Talk about how these truths apply, especially when considering the phrase, "Unconditional love cannot exist when all the conditions are met."
- How does passionately pursuing Jesus affect how a man passionately pursues his wife?
- Take some time to pray together.
