DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

For the week of April 23, 2023

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- If you could only watch one sport for the rest of your life, what would it be?
- What is your favorite memory from the Olympics?
- Read Genesis 3:1-6 and talk through the progression of temptation that led to the eating of the fruit.
- What was the lie that Eve believed and how did she 'entertain' that lie before acting upon it?
- How have you (or others) experienced a similar progression of temptation?
- Talk about this statement, "If you don't control what you think, you won't control what you do."
- Josh compared "identifying our areas of struggle" with cobwebs and "identifying the lie(s) we have believed" with spiders. How would you explain this?
- Read and talk through II Corinthians 10:3-5.
- "The only way to overcome lies is with truth." Read Hebrews 4:12. Would you say you treat Scripture like it's living and active or just like words on a page?
- Look at the handout. Which lie, truth, or affirmation stands out to you?
- "Freedom is found in the same way it is lost...THINKING BELIEVING -BEHAVING." Compare how Eve followed this pattern to how we should follow this pattern. Explain what it looks like in real life for us to do this.
- Take some time to pray together.
