DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

For the week of May 21, 2023

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to "break the ice" and get people talking)

- "My wish, for you" is a song that 'hits you in the feels.' What is another song that does this for you?
- Graduation is a way to celebrate an accomplishment. What is an accomplishment that you are proud to have completed?
- Before Sunday's sermon, what would you have thought would be every pastor's 'wish' for the people they lead spiritually? Did your answer change after reading through II Peter 1?
- Read II Peter 1:2 and talk about how "grace and peace" are "multiplied."
 Read II Peter 1:3 and talk about where we can find "all things that pertain to life and godliness."
- Read II Peter 1:4 and talk about what sanctification has looked like in your life. Share a story about how God has conformed you into the image of Jesus.
- "It's not a religion. It's a relationship." Why is it so easy to focus on religion rather than an abiding walk in relationship with Jesus?
- Look at the things listed in II Peter 1:5-7. The next verse tells us that these things help us to grow in our knowledge of Jesus. How would you explain this?
- Talk about different ways that we can grow in our knowledge of Jesus. Are there any practical things you have done that has helped you in this area?
