

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

For the week of July 2, 2023

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to “break the ice” and get people talking)

- What is an area of your life that in which you find it very difficult to be patient?
- On a scale of 1-10, how patient do you think you are with others? Can you share why you gave this answer?
- Being honest and vulnerable, who do you struggle being patient with? Why?
- Who is the most patient person you know with other people? How do they show it?
- Read Hebrews 10:36 and 12:1. What difference does it make in our lives when we live with patience?
- Read I Peter 1:6-7. Josh said that we can be patient when we realize that “God is either working on IT or working on YOU.” Talk about a time that you have seen this as being true.
- Read Galatians 6:9 and talk about this statement, “If we are lacking patience, we do not have a patience problem, we have a faith problem.”
- Talk about a time that God was patient with you.
- If patience is a “willingness to wait” and a “willingness to trust,” then what can we do to keep these thoughts in mind?
- Take some time to pray together.

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
