

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

For the week of August 20, 2023

One of the best things you can do after hearing truths from the Word of God is to talk about them with others. Here are some questions to help get the conversation started. (hint: the first couple of questions are meant to “break the ice” and get people talking)

- What is a part of your (or your family's) routine that might seem 'odd' to others?
- If time and resources were not a problem/issue, what ministry would you love to be involved in?
- What are some typical responses when people are asked if they know for sure that they are right with God and destined to spend eternity with him?
- What do these verses say about whether, or not, a person can know for sure that they are saved? - II Corinthians 13:5, II Peter. 1:10
- What is the “recipe” for assurance of salvation according to II Peter. 1:10. (hint: don't forget the context of this verse)
- What does it look like to “be diligent” to “do these things” in our daily lives?
- What is something that God has done through you that has produced an assurance of your salvation?
- Read II Peter 1:10 and talk about the difference between “falling” and “falling away.”
- Talk about a time that you struggled with either assurance or falling away. Did one of the things found in I Peter 1:5-7 help with this?
- Take some time to pray together.

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
